

Travel Policy

This policy will be in effect until guidance is revised from the Government Protocols for Travelers.

This policy is based on the current guidance from the Government Protocols for Travelers and is subject to change as Government guidance is revised. <https://www.gov.bm/coronavirus-travellers>

Upon travel to Bermuda from Tuesday August the 25th, families must follow the Government Protocols for Travelers.

This policy will apply for our families, family members lived with, visitors and staff.

Upon arrival to Bermuda from traveling abroad Residents of Bermuda must Quarantine and have their 8th day PRC COVID-19 test resulting negative.

To return to school after travel:

- 1) Communicate in writing travel plans and chosen testing regime to the Person in Charge.
- 2) Adults and Children aged 10 and up in the household must test negative on their PRC-COVID-19 test from day 8.
- 3) Submit written clearance from ones Doctor for the household OR present household members negative results.

For students to be at school after family member or visitor in the household travel:

- 1) Resident: Adults and Children aged 10 and up in the household must test negative on their PRC-COVID-19 test from day 8.

Visitor: Medical clearance is given after negative result from Arrival PRC-COVID-19 test.
